

Subject:	Long-term intermittent physical therapy and exercise therapy for patients with fibromyalgia
Summary:	The College voor zorgverzekeringen (CVZ) commissioned the Dutch Cochrane Centre to carry out research into the efficacy and safety of physical therapy and exercise therapy for patients with fibromyalgia.  CVZ's outcome of assessment, based on the results of this research, is that long-term, intermittent, physical therapy and exercise therapy is not treatment that complies with the established medical science and medical practice criterion.  This means that physical therapy and exercise therapy treatment for patients with fibromyalgia is not care that is insured under the Zorgverzekeringswet (Health Insurance Act).
