Subject:	Endovascular treatment techniques in cases of trunk varices
Summary:	This assessment is an update of CVZ's assessment in 2008 regarding the various endovascular treatment techniques for trunk varices.
	Based on a recent literature study, CVZ's conclusion is that foam sclerotherapy as treatment of stem varices is not an insured provision under the <i>Zorgverzekeringswet</i> (ZVW, Health Insurance Act). This is the same as CVZ's assessment in 2008.
	CVZ's assessment dating from 2008 regarding endovenous laser treatment and radiofrequency ablation is unaltered: both treatments for trunk varices are designated as provisions insured under the Zvw.
	The update does not alter the previous assessment in 2008
	In a separate report CVZ will discuss the relationship between varices and complaints/symptoms and the medical necessity of invasive treatment. Within that framework, attention will be given to whether/how a clear distinction can be drawn between the medically necessary treatment of varices and treatments that are only cosmetic in nature. This distinction is important because, in principle, the last-mentioned treatments are not regarded as provisions insured under the Zvw.
