

Subject:	Case Management
Summary:	<p>CVZ has drawn up an inventory of the elements that make up case management, and assessed whether this can be regarded as an insured provision.</p> <p>CVZ has investigated whether case management complies with the established medical science and medical practice criterion. Prerequisites for effective case management are a sound organisation, with proper protocols, indication criteria and formalised collaboration that is respected by the parties involved.</p> <p>Care in the form of case management, as normally provided by G.P.s and as normally provided by nurses. As the Zvw takes precedence over the AWBZ, this is Zvw-care. An insured patient is only said to depend on case management if simpler forms of coordination are inadequate.</p> <p>The indication criteria must have been determined in the provision which is subsequently purchased by the health insurer.</p>
