

Subject:	<b>Zygoma implants in cases of atrophic edentulous maxilla</b>
Summary:	<p>In this outcome of assessment, CVZ examines whether using zygoma implants to treat atrophic edentulous maxilla (upper jaw) can be regarded as an insured provision (under the basic insurance). This relates to an innovative application submitted to DBC-Maintenance. CVZ is responsible for answering the question of whether an innovative intervention can be regarded as an insured provision.</p> <p>The central question is whether using zygoma implants to treat atrophic edentulous maxilla complies with the established medical science and medical practice criterion, which would mean this intervention/indication combination is covered by the basic insurance.</p> <p>CVZ's reply to this question is negative: using zygoma implants to treat atrophic edentulous maxilla does not comply with the established medical science and medical practice criterion. This outcome of assessment has no consequences for implementation in practice.</p>
